OUR LAST MEETING MINUTES

At our last meeting, we went over budget matters, and we can now report that we have \$50 in our treasury, with expenses to date of \$4.20 (postage for our last newsletter). We also have several checks pending deposit.

We decided that it was not worthwhile to open a checking account for our club, since the account

fees would eat up our entire budget. For the time being, President Klaus Huenecke will "co-mingle" the funds with his private account, and give us a reporting on our treasury status.

President Don Eilenberger also reported on the discussion he had with the outgoing President of the New Sweden BMW Riders. As you may know, New Sweden runs the largest rally in New Jersey (and I believe the ONLY rally in New Jersey).

This rally is run in the fall, just outside Atlantic City. Since we are seeking experience in running this type of event, President Don asked if the New Sweden club would be interested in our assistance. This offer was warmly received, and as more information becomes available, Prez Don will report to our members.

We again discussed the design for a club patch. The consensus was that the patch design could be the same as the logo design that is in the first column of this newsletter. Prez Don is pursuing finding out what the cost of getting patches made will be.

President Kent Seydell explained the problems we would encounter if we attempted to run our own Motorcycle Safety Foundation Experienced Rider Course, and at his suggestion, we decided to look into offerings from other organizations. (More on this later).

The meeting ended at about 9:30PM after viewing a video Kent brought along on motorcycle maintenance and winter storage.

MSF / ERC UPDATE

As was mentioned earlier, we've found we cannot run our own MSF-ERC course at this time. President Don tracked down courses being given locally (sponsored by Rider Education of NJ) at Brookdale College in Lincroft.

The dates the course is offered are:

June 17th and Sept. 23

This course is an all day course, about equally split between classroom and range time.

The cost to NJ residents is only \$25 (part of the cost of the course is paid for by your annual motorcycle registration fee)!

If you are interested in attending one of the courses as part of our club let us know, OR if we can find 12 people who are interested in taking the course, Rider Education of NJ can set up a course just for our club, at the location of our choice! We also would like to discuss upcoming events, and ask some members/presidents to take responsibility for organizing them.
