

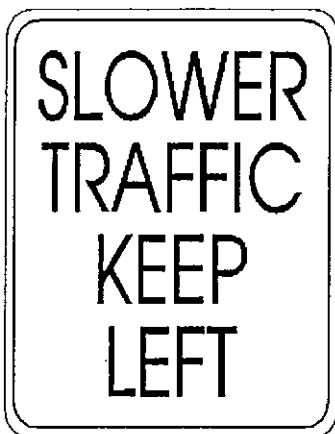
New Jersey Shore BMW Riders

CLUB NEWS Gonna be a short one! What's been happening? LOTS of Sunday Rides! Every weekend since our last meeting!

SUNDAY RIDES:

Sunday 10/15/1995: Kent Seydell took the initiative and made a few calls. Three riders (*Kent, Dennis Swanson and Don Eilenberger*) ended up taking a long day's ride to **Beemerville NJ!**



The ride started by heading northwest out of Freehold on Cty. Rt. 522, which we followed to Cty. Rt. 608 to Rt. 518 - which led us to the best of NJ roads - County Rt. 579 heading north (starting at Ringos). If you have never travelled 579 on two wheels - DO IT! A wonderful road. Lightly traveled, well paved and twisty, up and down mountains - with great scenery the entire way!

At Phillipsburg, we picked up County Rt. 519 - the equal of 579. Both roads wander through the western mountains of NJ, alternating between valley bottom and mountaintop! The leaves were turning in the northland - and the ride was SPECTACULAR!

After reaching Beemerville (about 5 miles west of High Point NJ), we started back, following Rt. 206, where we made a lunch stop at Ross Corner (where 206 meets with Rt. 15). We continued down 206 through Newton, Netcong and Bedminster - where we picked up Rt. 287 heading west. Shortly after, we accidentally split up (Don got off on 206, following Dennis - who then got back on 206 - Don continued, and Kent took 287 all the way to the Parkway and home).

Great day - perfect weather - great ride!

Sunday 10/22/1995: Although the weekend was planned for our overnight Stromboli/Cranberry Festival Ride and then a ride to New Sweden BMW Riders flea market - the weather did us in on Saturday. SO, we decided to head out Sunday (bright and clear) to the New Sweden flea market - and then see what developed! Riders *Joe Christy, Bill Brown and Don Eilenberger* left Don's house shortly after the planned time of 9AM - headed for our second pickup point of the Allenwood General Store. On the way to the store, Bill's new R100G/S crapped out with a dead battery. Some pushing

by Joe and Don got it started again, and Bill ran for home with it. In the meantime, *Rich Riegler* passed us, stopped, and we sent him on to the Allenwood General Store to tell anyone waiting we were on our way. Shortly after, we joined Rich and *Dennis Swanson* at the general store - minus Bill.

Our four riders headed out to Rt. 70 (not bad on a Sunday morning) - took it to Rt. 73, a short jog south to County Route 544 - which heads southwest directly into Depford NJ - the home of RK BMW and the New Sweden flea market. The ride down took about 1.5 hours.

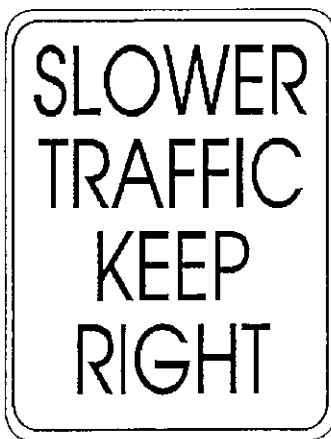
At the flea market - we met up with members *Harold Gantz, Mike Kowal and Joe Genelli*. Joe and Mike had caged it since they were looking for heavier bargains. Shortly after we arrived, Bill Brown reappeared on his K75 - he'd gone home, had breakfast and swapped bikes!

President Don bought his usual R65 tank at the flea-market (and everyone stocked up on maintenance and spares - since we don't have a dealer in our area). We finally pushed off at about 1:30PM - and headed northwest towards the center of the Pines.

After wandering through the pines - we finally got to Chatsworth - the home of the annual Cranberry Festival. Problem was - everyone who was gonna go to the festival on Saturday and got rained out, and everyone who was gonna go on Sunday - ALL went on Saturday! The streets were wall to wall people! We only made a short stop - and then continued on towards home. Another great day - another great ride!

Sunday 10/29/1995: -

Another inpromtu Sunday ride - which was sorta discussed at Kent and Liz Seydell's Friday "New Beginnings" party (more on this later..). At 9AM, Prez Don was woken up by the sound of *Bill Brown* pounding on his front door - with the question "Want to go for a ride?" Prez Don was almost awake (but not dressed) since Prez *Joe Christy* had called earlier to propose a ride, so while Don got dressed - Bill called Joe - and we all took off at about 10:15AM.



The ride was a flea-market run - we first visited the New Egypt flea market (going out Rt. 524 to Rt. 537) then to the Columbus flea market via Rt. 206 (on the way back, Prez Don visited Collingswood Auction).

The day was clear and very windy (gusts to about 30 mph) and a bit cool, but all riders were electrified and comfortable!

We headed back on 537, stopping for a late lunch at Johnny B's (537 and 524), and then splitting up for home!
